Personal Statement: At present, I am a senior lecturer in the Department of Anaesthesiology and Critical Care in the Faculty of Medicine University of Peradeniya and serving as an honorary consultant in Anaesthesiology and Critical Care to the Teaching Hospital, Peradeniya.

After qualifying with MBBS and completing the internship, I served as a Medical Officer in Anaesthesiology in the Ministry of Health attached to Base Hospital Diyathalawa, Badulla and Mahiyangana from April 1997. Since I was interested in pursuing an academic career related to anaesthesiology, I joined the Faculty of Dental Sciences, University of Peradeniya as a lecturer in Anaesthesiology in October of 2001.

I was attached to the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine as a Registrar and Senior Registrar in Anaesthesiology and worked at the Teaching Hospital, Kandy, National Hospital Colombo and Apeksha Hospital, Maharagama.
