Workshop Description: This workshop provides both methodological principles and practical "hands-on" approaches to translate "best-practices" to driving scholarship, innovation, and integration of AI tools for research in Sri Lanka. Health professions educators of all backgrounds are welcome. Open to educators of all levels and experience. Session will cover the following topics:

Workshop Faculty

Workshop faculty are educational leaders and clinicians from the Department of Medical Education at the University of Illinois College of Medicine, USA.



Brian Gin, MD, PhD is an Associate Professor in the Departments of Medical Education and Pediatrics at the University of Illinois College of Medicine. Dr. Gin's work focuses on understanding the process of entrusting trainees with clinical responsibilities and developing AI methods to enhance research, learning, assessment, and clinical decision-making. Dr. Gin aims to "democratize" AI within HPE by developing open-source AI toolkits that equip users to collaborate freely in this emerging field. As AI begins to play more significant roles in HPE and clinical practice, he is also actively developing frameworks to guide the entrustment of AI itself. Learn more here



Lauren Maggio, PhD is a Professor and the Director of Research in the Department of Medical Education at the University of Illinois College of Medicine. Her research focuses on the creation, dissemination, and use of information and has resulted in more than 150 peer-reviewed publications. An internationally recognized methodologist, Dr. Maggio specializes in literature reviews and qualitative methods and is frequently invited to present and lead workshops around the world. She served as the Deputy Editor-in-Chief for *Perspectives on Medical Education* (2019-2024), and currently serves as Editor-in-Chief of *MedEdPORTAL*, the Association of American Medical Colleges' journal of teaching and learning resources, and holds multiple editorial roles, including positions on the *Academic Medicine* editorial board. Dr. Maggio is also a certified executive coach. Learn more here.



Yoon Soo Park, PhD is the Ilene B. Harris Professor and Department Head of Medical Education at the University of Illinois College of Medicine. Dr. Park's work has focused on assessment methodologies, artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning, and learning analytics. His work in health professions education has advanced the preparation of learners in clinical reasoning and measurement of competencies through validity studies. Dr. Park served as Vice President of the American Educational Research Association (AERA; 2018-2021) and Chair of Research in Medical Education for the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC; 2019-2020). He is active in international collaborations, in both research in teaching. Learn more here.



Ara Tekian, PhD, MHPE is Professor and Associate Dean for International Education at the University of Illinois College of Medicine. He is involved in teaching courses in both the master's and the doctorate programs in Professions Education. He is a leading scholar in professions education with significant and sustained research contributions that have made groundbreaking impact on educational practices of health professionals, both within the United States and around the world. He has published over 200 peer-reviewed journal articles and presented over 190 peer-reviewed presentations. He teaches widely, conducting over 325 invited workshops and courses, and 275 invited presentations, in over 45 countries. His work has been consistently supported by extramural funding totaling over \$5 million. His numerous awards include the Association for the Study of Medical Education ASME Gold Medal in recognition of his scholarship and leadership in international contexts. Learn more here.
