The main drive behind Prof. Gawarammana is the South Asian Clinical Toxicology Research Collaboration (SACTRC), housed at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Peradeniya. SACTRC is an international collaboration comprising number of clinicians and researchers from many countries including Sri Lanka, UK, Germany, Denmark and Australia studying the treatment of acute pesticide self-poisoning in the developing world, and working to reduce suicide deaths and morbidity in Asia. The Collaboration has been working with the Ministry of Health in Sri Lanka since the mid-1980s. Its work is funded mainly by the UK's Wellcome Trust and Australia's NHMRC. Work carried out by SACTRC has helped save 140,000 lives from pesticide poisoning mainly through regulation of pesticide imports based on data produced by the group.
