## Information sheet for medical undergraduates Radiology short clinical appointment

- All the students should read the objectives of the Radiology Clinical Appointment available in the Web / hard copy given by the department/ students hand book.
- All students in the group are expected to be present on Monday at 8.00am at the Department of Radiology for OSPE pre-test. There will be 05 Nos. spots (Plain X-ray or CT) on common pathological condition. These x-rays will be discussed at the end of OSPE.
- The monitor of the group is responsible for
  - Collecting the attendance register on Monday from Mr. Parakum Ekanayake, at the Department of Radiology.
  - Returning the attendance register to the Department of Radiology on Saturday at 12.00 noon
  - Handle pre and test and post test material to be discussed with the relevant consultant radiologist an returning them back to the radiology department at the Faculty of Medicine
  - Should allocate the group into 4-5 groups so that 2/3 students will be in CT/US/Plain X-ray/angio room/mammography/ appointment room/x-ray reporting room
  - Hand over the record books of the group to the radiology department at the Faculty of Medicine immediately after the clinical appointment for signature of the head of the department.[ late submissions are not entertained]
  - Feedback forms must be return after the post test.
- Students are expected to study patients who attend the Radiology Department for various investigations during the time allocated for self learning and bring clinical material / problems they have encountered to be discussed at the group discussion.
- Students are also expected to study radiological anatomy of (eg: CXR, AXR, L/S Spine and CT Brain and Abdomen) the images of the patients always with pathology.
- On the last day of the appointment a post-test (10 nos. of plain X-ray or CT) will be conducted.
- 80% Attendance of the clinical appointments and >= 50% at the post-test is required to obtain the signature in the record book.
- Feedback form should be duly completed at the end of appointment by each student.
