

Introductory Clinical Appointment
DAY-TO-DAY STRUCTURE

100% attendance is expected in all components of the course.

In accordance with the new format of the introductory appointment, the day-to-day structure for mornings is given below. 8.00 – 9.00 a.m. lecture on the 1st Day and all the 11.00 – 12.00 noon lectures will be held in the WEST Lecture Theatre.

04 major groups of students will be in rotation among the professorial units in the AFTERNOONS during the 4 weeks appointment.
