## OBJECTIVES OF THE INTRODUCTORY SURGICAL APPOINTMENT WHICH IS ALSO CALLED THE MSGOP

(This could be renamed as the  $1^{st}$  surgical appointment and the subsequent appointments named the  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  surgical appointments)

## **CLINICAL SKILLS:**

Using common acute and non acute surgical conditions

(For eg. Acute – appendicitis, non-acute – elective hernia) Drill the students in the technique of history taking and physical examination and proper documentation there of.

## THEORITICAL KNOWLEDGE WITH PRACTICAL EXPOSURE

Each student should read and be familiar with the contents of a book on history taking and physical examination in relation to surgery.

The students should get an understanding of the use of the operating theatre as a place where surgical treatment is carried out.

The students should be exposed to the different presentations of infections and be able to appreciate the importance of asepsis in a hospital environment.

## PRACTICAL SKILLS:

To acquire some degree of professional discipline with respect to punctuality, honesty and courtesy to patients and staff members. To learn to behave in an appropriate manner in the hospital environment.
