## SHORT COURSE ON ANALYSIS OF COUNT AND RANK DATA

23 - 26 September 2014

Board of Study in Biostatistics Postgraduate Institute of Agriculture (PGIA) University of Peradeniya

### INTRODUCTION

Most of the experiments and surveys result in count and rank data which cannot be analyzed by parametric statistical procedures such as t-tests, analysis of variances (ANOVA) and regression. For results to be reliable and valid, the analysis of count and rank data should be based on correct statistical proceedures. Due to widespread use and increasing importance of statistical methods for analyzing count and rank data, it is essential for researchers and users to obtain a firm understanding of the philosophical basis, the principles and a broad knowledge of analyzing count and rank data.

#### COURSE OBJECTIVE

The short course offered by the Board of Study in Biostatistics, Postgraduate Institute of Agriculture (PGIA) will provide a broad knowledge and skills of statistical methods for analyzing count and rank data for a wide variety of academic disciplines including medicine, agriculture, food science, veterinary, economics, social sciences, engineering, natural and physical sciences.

The course comprises of lectures followed by practicals where participants will get hands-on experience in analyzing a wide variety of experimental and survey data using statistical software SAS®.

#### TARGET GROUP

The short course is aimed at mid career professionals in universities, research institutes, government and nongovernment organizations and industry. Participants should preferably have knowledge in basic statistics.

#### COURSE CONTENTS

Scales of Measurements; Testing Proportions; Sample Size Determination; Analysis of Contingency Tables; Goodness of Fit Tests; Approximate and Exact Tests; Log Linear Models; Model Selection; Logistic Regression. Nonparametric Tests: Sign, Wilcoxon Rank Sum, Wilcoxon Signed Rank, Kruskal-Wallis, Friedman, Durbin, Kolmogrov and Smirnove; Rank Correlation and Covariance Analysis; Nonparametric Regression.

#### COURSE DURATION AND VENUE

Four days (23-26 September 2014) from 8.30 AM to 4.30 PM. Venue: Postgraduate Institute of Agriculture (PGIA), Old Galaha Road, University of Peradeniya, Peradeniya.

#### COURSE FEE

Rs. 15,000 per participant (includes tea, lunch and course material). Accommodation will not be provided.
