Staff Development Centre, Eastern University, Sri Lanka conduct Certificate in "Teaching Methodology" from second week of July 2014. This is the 5th programme organized by the SDC since its inception in Eastern University, Sri Lanka.

The Staff Development Centre, Eastern University, Sri Lanka is always aiming to enhance the knowledge and skills of the communities in the university system in Sri Lanka to obtain an efficient and affective service from the staff in a friendly environment in general and to contribute to the national development in specific.

The course is intended for junior permanent academic staff involved in Teaching and Learning. This course is an accredidated programme by the UGC Commission, satisfying the mandatory segments to be fulfilled by probationary academics.
