

IIM was founded as "College of Ayurveda" and subsequently upgraded and affiliated to the University of Colombo in the year 1977 as the Institute of Indigenous Medicine.

Sri Lankan Indigenous Medicine

The Sri Lankan Indigenous medical system is as ancient as the civilization of the Island itself. This is called Deshiya chikitsa, which is the Indigenous medical system of Sri Lanka.

Sri Lanka developed its own medical system based on unique traditions and pedigrees known as Veda parampara. The ancient Kings, who were also prominent physicians, sustained the survival of Sri Lankan medical system.

The history of our medical system goes back far as Emperor Ravana, who lived nearly 5000 years ago. He was a great scholar in Traditional medicine and wrote many books such as Arka Prakashaya and Kumara Tantraya. King Buddhadasa (398 AD), one of the most influential Kings who were physicians wrote Sarartha samgrahaya, which is used even today for reference. the ruins of the first hospital in the world can be found in Mihintale, Sri Lanka.

Themes

The main theme of the symposium is **Holistic** health through Traditional Medicine.
