## World's Most Comprehensive Women's University, Cradle of Future Leadership

Since its foundation in 1886 with a single student, Ewha Womans University has spearheaded many changes that have shaped the history of women's education in Korea.

- Ewha's proud pioneers include a long series of Korea's firsts—the country's first woman Ph.D., medical doctor, lawyer, CEO, Minister of Government Legislation, and Prime Minister.
- Among women lawmakers appointed to the 19<sup>th</sup> National Assembly (2012-2016), 27.6% are Ewha alumnae.
- Departments nationally ranked 1<sup>st</sup>: English Literature & Language, History, Sociology, Law, Education, Mathematics, Physics, and Environmental Science and Engineering.
