### 03. Number of Students to be Admitted

There is no exact quota for the number of international students to be admitted. Candidates are selected upon review of their academic ability, through a special admission process for foreign students.

## 04. Eligibility to Apply

Eligible to apply when international applicants satisfy all of the following requirements

#### 1. Nationality: Female foreign nationals whose parents are both foreign nationality.

- \* Korean citizens (including dual citizenship of applicant and both parents) will not be considered eligible for admission
- \*K Korean who obtained foreign nationals(applicant and both parents) are eligible only if she and her parents obtained their foreign nationals before entering her secondary school(Grade 10) (Only applicable to undergraduate applicants)
