



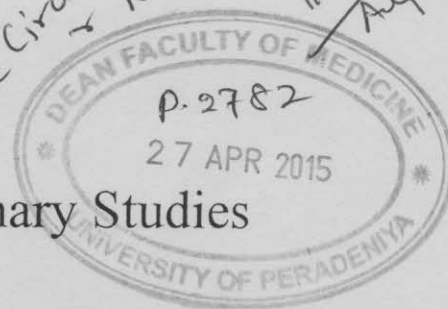
# Call for Papers

### Aims & Scope

International Journal of Multidisciplinary Studies (IJMS) provides a supportive environment for multidisciplinary researchers to publish their contribution to the academy of knowledge and wisdom. Focus of the journal is on multidisciplinary research. A research to be multidisciplinary it should have work covering at least two distinct disciplines. IJMS accepts submission of research articles, original works, reviews and conceptual works for publication.

### CRITERIA FOR PUBLICATION

Articles submitted to the journal should be original and should not have been published or submitted to another journal in their current or substantially similar form. All authors are required to take the total responsibility for the content of the paper and are required to sign a declaration form for originality and ownership of the content. The editor may make use of an available Software for checking the originality of submissions received. The authors should affirm that the work submitted to the journal does not violate any existing copyright and should assure the publisher against any breach of such warranty. In order to maintain ethical standards in publishing, journal will seek the advice of **COPE (Committee on Publication Ethics)** - <http://www.publicationethics.org/>, which allows the journal to handle cases of research and publication misconduct. Authors may retain the copy rights to their published material.

The articles that fulfill the journal criteria will be sent to two independent referees for double blind peer review. Based on their recommendations and the comments, the Editor -in- Chief has the right to decide whether the paper should be accepted as it is, or resubmitted with revisions or rejected.

Authors are expected to write manuscripts simple and concise whilst assuring all important aspects of a high quality publication. Manuscripts should be about 4000 to 5000 words written in Times New Roman 12- point font double spaced and should have an abstract maximum of 250 words, key words maximum of 10, references (at least 10), and discussion questions (up to five) as well as any relevant tables, figures, and appendixes. The Editor has the discretion to allocate additional space to papers that intend to make very extensive contributions or that require additional space for data presentation or references (such as meta-analyses, qualitative works, and work using multiple data sets).

## Submission of Manuscripts

To submit a manuscript for consideration authors are required to :

(1) Format the manuscript in Microsoft Word. (2) Separate the title page and all author-identifying references. (3) E-mail by May 15, 2014 to the IJMS Editor-in-Chief at [ijms@sjp.ac.lk](mailto:ijms@sjp.ac.lk)
