CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Sri Lanka Association for Laboratory Animal Science (SLALAS) invites its members to submit abstracts to be considered for presentation at the Inaugural Scientific Sessions.

- A member of SLALAS (Life/ Regular/ Student) and an International Scientist who
 engage in animal research shall be permitted to submit an abstract of a paper for
 presentation at the Scientific Sessions, who shall be the Corresponding Author. A
 Corresponding Author may have co-authors, who are members of SLALAS or Session
 Members (any other scientist/ researcher who is not a member of SLALAS).
- 2. Number of abstracts that could be submitted by one Corresponding Author is limited to two (2).
- SLALAS will communicate on matters related to the respective abstract only with the Corresponding Author as indicated by all the authors in the attached consent form.
- 4. Only a member will be allowed to make a presentation (oral or poster) at the Scientific Sessions (In the case with abstract/s submitted by International Scientist/s, the International Scientist/s who will be the Corresponding Author/s will be allowed to make the presentation). The presenting author of the abstract is required to register for the Scientific Sessions at the time of abstract submission. In the event of an author being unable to make the presentation due to ill health or any other valid reason, the President shall be notified in writing prior to the day of the presentation (on the day of the presentation in the event of an emergency) and another member or a co-author shall then be allowed to make the presentation.
- Authors who are members of the Association should not be in arrears of membership fees
 including the current year subscription at the time of submitting the abstracts. All arrears
 should be paid before submitting abstracts.
- 6. The registration fee for the Scientific Sessions will be Rs. 2000/- per person for locals. The registration fee for International Scientists will be US\$100.
- 7. Abstracts together with the consent form and other relevant documents must be submitted for consideration. In the absence of all required documents, the abstract will be rejected. Abstracts must be prepared according to the Guidelines given and these will be referred prior to acceptance.

- 8. Receipt of submission of abstracts will be acknowledged to the Corresponding Author by e-mail after the closing date.
- 9. Abstracts will be refereed by two reviewers.
- 10. On the request of the reviewers, a two (2) page extended abstract could be requested from the Corresponding Authors where the scientific material given cannot be assessed based on the short abstract already submitted.
- 11. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent to the Corresponding Author within 2 months with instructions for any improvements and resubmission of the final version if the abstract is accepted. The reviewers will decide whether the abstract is accepted for oral or poster presentation.
- 12. Please note that NO amendments to the submitted abstract (title or contents or authors) would be entertained once the Corresponding Authors are informed of the decision of acceptance of the abstract.
- 13. By submitting an abstract author(s) agree to allow publication of the abstract in the Abstract book which will be distributed among all who got registered for Scientific Sessions of SLALAS.
- 14. A hardcopy of the abstract and a CD containing the abstract should be submitted with the duly completed consent form and a copy of the Ethics clearance to the President of SLALAS before 4.00 p.m. on Monday the 30th September 2013 (could be sent under registered post or hand delivered). Late entries will not be accepted. CD should contain a label indicating Corresponding Author's name and the title of the Abstract.
- 15. If an accepted abstract is not presented (oral or poster) at the Sessions, the Corresponding Author will not be allowed to present any paper at the SLALAS session for a period of three years, unless the reason/s for not presenting have been accepted by the executive Committee.
- 16. The decision of the SLALAS executive Committee shall be final on any matter related to abstracts.

FORMAT OF THE ABSTRACT

- 1. All abstracts must be in English, prepared using MS-Word, Times New Roman font size 12 in a A4 size paper with double spacing and 2.5 cm (1 inch) margins.
- 2. The title of the abstract should be in upper case and should be brief but adequately descriptive. The SLALAS reserves the right to modify the title where necessary.
- 3. Author's name should be preceded by the initial(s) but not by prefixes such as Mr, Ms, Dr or Professor. The names of all the Authors and the affiliation should be mentioned in the title page. Do not include qualifications here. Name of the Corresponding Author should be marked with an asterisk (*) and the Presenting Author should be underlined.

- 4. Abstracts must be based on original work which should include five (5) key words, the purpose of the study, methods and materials used, statistical tests used, results obtained and the conclusion. The Abstract should not exceed 250 words of text (excluding title of paper, names and affiliations of authors and key words). Statements such as "Conclusion will be discussed at the Sessions" are unacceptable. (Subtitles such as purpose of the study/objectives, Materials and methods, results, conclusion, statement about previous presentation or publication and acknowledgments of funding source/s should not be counted for the word limit of the abstract)
- 5. The Author/s should take the responsibility for the research work and the contents reported in the abstract.
- 6. If the work has been previously presented or published, in whole or in part, this should be stated clearly in the abstract. This does not disqualify a paper but must be indicated when submitting an abstract.
- 7. The SLALAS reserves the right to edit the abstract to improve its quality.
- 8. Abstracts not conforming to the above instructions will be rejected.

PRESENTATION OF PAPERS

Oral Presentations:

Each paper will be allowed only ten (10) minutes for presentation and two (2) minutes for discussion. Multimedia facilities will be made available for presentations.

Poster presentations:

The size of the poster should be approximately 1m (width) X 1.5m (height). Posters should be made on material which can be mounted easily.
