#### Instructions

# In-course assessment -----7.5 % will be taken to infection I module examination

- 1). Keep record books/identity cards open on the bench
- 2). Each table will have 4 students and two such tables will be assigned to one examiner and a technical officer
- Write your index number clearly on the answer script provided to you
  Wait for examiner's instructions to start. Each table might start differently
- 4). Make sure that you are being examined / observed at each step
- 5). Once you focus under oil, draw and describe what you see on the answer script provided. Then call the examiner and show both what is written and the focused area. Do NOT call examiner to see anything other than that
- 6). Please call for help if you need help with focusing. Only 5 marks will be deducted, and you will get the marks for the other steps
- 7). One bell will be ringing 5 minutes before the completion time
- 8). Once you have completed the whole procedure, hand over the answer script and wash hands and leave
